Learners' Information Sheet for Intermediate Certificate in Dog Grooming Level 2

About the Qualification

- NPTC has produced this accredited vocationally related qualification in conjunction with the Pet Care Trust.

Key Points

- It is suitable for candidates:-
 - for whom N/SVQs are not a suitable option.
 - who wish for career progression in this sector.
 - who are looking for progression into further higher education.
 - who are entering the dog grooming industry.
 - who are not yet sufficiently advanced to study for the Advanced Certificate in Dog Grooming.
- The qualification can be taken in the workplace, college or training centre.
- This qualification is available for candidates aged 16 and over.
- No formal entry requirements are needed but a general knowledge of dogs would be an advantage, and a suitable level of literacy and numeracy to enable candidates research the underpinning knowledge and complete the assessments.

Benefits of the Qualification

- The qualification is accredited by the Qualifications and Curriculum Authority at Levels 2. The Intermediate Certificate in Dog Grooming supports the government initiative toward the National Qualifications Framework.

Assessment

The Level 2 Intermediate Certificate in Dog Grooming comprises of 3 core units. Assessment is by unit practical tests and a multiple choice exam.

The multiple choice exam is taken through the Global On-Line Assessment (GOLA) system.

Unit certification can be issued if candidates prefer to complete the qualification incrementally for Continuous Professional Development.

Units for Level 2 Intermediate Certificate in Dog Grooming

- Unit 201: The dog grooming work environment
- Unit: 202 Prepare dogs for bathing
- Unit 203: Bath, dry and prepare dogs for styling

What's the next step?

In the first instance you need to view the City & Guilds website (www.cityandguilds.com). Click on the City & Guilds red car to stay on the City & Guilds site. Then select 'Learners' and then 'Adult learners'. Follow the prompts through to the qualifications you are looking for. If you click on the qualification, you can then enter your postcode to find your nearest Assessment Centre. The Centre will be able to advise you on the training and assessment of the qualification.
